

Developing Effective Treatment Plans

Course Description:

Developing Effective Treatment is a one-day training designed to help counselors develop treatment planning skills. Building plans that are individualized, strength-based, and oriented toward specific client needs is a challenge. Often agencies conduct a comprehensive assessment using instruments like the Addiction Severity Index and fail to use the information effectively in treatment planning or ongoing case management.

This course will provide participants with an opportunity to learn and practice incorporating assessment information into every day clinical processes. The course emphasizes how to make treatment plans **Measurable, Attainable, Time-limited, Realistic and Specific (MATRS)**.

Participants will practice using assessment information in crafting treatment plans that are both useful and conform to standards established by state administrative rules and national accreditation organizations.
